Reduction in Public Health Workforce Nationally*

- Public health departments have cut 1/5th of workforce since 2008.
- > 1/2 will have cut services in the first half of 2011.

SJBHD Reserves Used to Fund Operations

- 2010: ~ \$165,000
- 2011: estimated \$300,000

- Increase availability for immunizations.
- Continue Family Planning
- Integrated clinic.
- Decrease cancellations & no show appointments.

Services Added

Community Care Team

- Born from CHAC Recommendation, Integrated Child Health & Senior Outreach Nurse
- Nurse Navigators focused on chronically ill and underserved clients.
- Interested community partners met for over a year and a half.
- Funding secured: Mercy, PPSW, La Plata County & RMHP.

Community Health & Capacity Assessment

- Joint effort between SJBHD, MRMC & PSMC.
- Meets current requirement for public health and non-profit hospitals.
